Our masonry division is a highly capable manufacturing facility. This includes profiling and specialist equipment we are also pioneering new equipment to ensure we deliver the best stone masonry and products available in the market.

We have a team of highly trained stonemasons on site, who are all experienced in traditional masonry construction, including fixings and restraints, as well as sensitive restoration techniques.

Using clients and architects elevation drawings, photos and ideas, we are able to draw up detailed blueprints.

Alternatively we have onsite draughtsmen who can create original bespoke detailed drawings. From which we can manufacture high end products in our masonry division and production facility at the quarry.

It is less than 37 miles from our masonry division to our quarry. This ensures a quick turn around from quarry to finished cut product. We deliver straight to site and, if necessary, we can install it using our experienced team of stone masons. We also have a skilled team of fixer masons to ensure the finished product is fitted to a high standard.






Our Stone

Exemplar oolitic limestone was formed in England during the Jurassic period over 165 million years ago and forms the Cotswold Hills, the Isle of Portland, with its famous Portland Stone, and part of the North Yorkshire Moors.

Quarried since the Roman times, this beautiful natural stone is responsible for the outstanding architectural beauty found in many Cotswold villages and cities, including the World Heritage City of Bath.

The natural limestone used in many of our products is quarried from our own Oxleaze and Grange Hill Quarries. Within each quarry, the stone varies in colour according to the seam, with colours ranging from buff, cream and grey tones.



Our Quarries

Our natural stone is sourced from our own quarries in the Cotswolds, alongside other British and European limestones and sandstones, and reclaimed products.

Having recently been awarded a 38 year excavation planning permission by our local planning authority for our Grange Hill quarry, this enables us to supply our stone for many years to come.

We have heavily invested and built a new production facility at the quarry to process our building and walling stone, giving us a much larger capability to service our growing customer base.



Our Master Craftsmen

Our stonemasons bring years of experience and craftsmanship to the process.

Combining hand skills with the latest machining technology, we are able to produce just about any interior and exterior architectural limestone masonry for private and commercial clients, large or small.

From cutting of hundreds of cubic metres of limestone ashlar blocks for the shell of a new stately home, to the cutting and engraving of commemorative paperweights and everything in between.

Our full in-house service consists of our natural stone gallery, stone procurement, design, manufacture, delivery, and fixing when required. We provide a reliable and professional single point destination for clients nationally and internationally.


Using client's elevation drawings, photos and ideas, the detailing of the masonry is created.


External Paving & Swimming Pool Surrounds

We can recommend a dry stone wall specialist to suit your project requirements.




Reclaimed Yorkstone

High quality finish with timeless appeal, the use of reclaimed materials has become more popular over recent years due to its positive environmental impact. Over time Yorkstone paving becomes well-worn and weathered, transforming the surface texture from a rough finish to a smooth one and really enhancing the colours in the stone.

Colour variations range from a light buff to darker grey, with textures ranging from a rough 'Riven' Yorkstone to a smooth 'Cathedral' Yorkstone.

Perfect for instantly adding an authentic look to period properties, or for matching 'like for like' replacements in conservation areas. Yorkstone can last for centuries so it makes sense to reuse it time and time again.


Cotswold Chippings
